Guide for Submission

[Minds and Machines](#) fosters a tradition of criticism within the AI and philosophical communities on problems and issues of common concern. Its scope explicitly encompasses philosophical aspects of computer science. In order to reflect the increasing contributions made by researchers residing in China in the areas of logic and artificial intelligence, and to both promote and strengthen the interdisciplinary studies on logic and computer science in China, the journal is now organizing this special issue. We welcome submissions in all areas of logic in AI, although preference will be given to submissions which demonstrate the best of recent advances by Chinese scientists in this area.

Author Instructions

1. Manuscripts must be clearly written in English.
2. Authors should submit postscript, PDF files via <http://www.editorialmanager.com/mind>. Each submission will be reviewed by two or three international reviewers. Submissions which cannot meet the high standard of the Journal will be rejected.
3. Work submitted for consideration must be previously un-published, not under consideration for publication elsewhere, and if accepted, it should not then be published elsewhere in the same form. If previously published figures, tables or parts of text are to be included, the copyright-holder's permission must have been obtained prior to submission.
4. In general, the paper length should be between 10-30 pages. (Please refer to the journal's page size).
